This charcoal & ink workshop will focus on TEXTURE and what better subject matter for texture than the mighty Elephant!

**Materials List:** *(Bring as much of this as you can. I will have spare of most things to loan & some to purchase incl. high quality Compressed Charcoal).*

**2b pencil** (or softer)

**3 types of charcoal:**

**1) willow 2) soft compressed** (NOT medium or hard - if in doubt buy from me on the day \$7-\$10)

**3) charcoal pencil** (monte marte SOFT)

*(Charcoal can be purchased from Eckersley's. Don't waste your money on the cheap brands which are mostly binder and impossible to get a decent effect with.)*

**Paper:** 1xFULL SHEET 300gsm Bockingford or other quality watercolour paper - I will have paper available on the day for \$10 per full sheet.

**Long ruler** 60cm

**Paper stumps**

**Low-tack tape** - available from Bunnings, Mitre 10 etc., or masking tape.

**Fixative** *(hairspray is fine if you don't plan for your workshop piece to be archival and last 50+ years!)*

*Various sized soft paintbrushes for dry 'painting' with charcoal (I find the synthetic taklon sets from Officeworks are best). NO BRISTLE brushes.*

**Mop brush** *(which is like a big loose watercolour brush for applying ink medium)*

**Hard eraser** *(available for purchase \$5 each)*

**3-4 small water containers**

**Apron** if you're messy (I'm always messy...)

**Water bottle**
