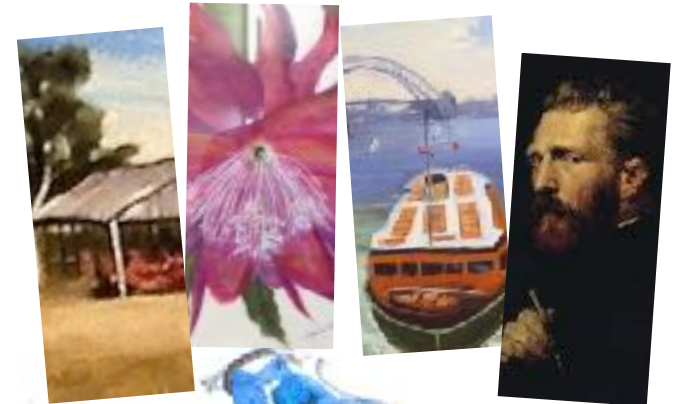

The Tuggerah Lakes Art Society was founded in 1989 by the late Robert Doyle, a local artist and teacher at the Ourimbah Community College. Robert was self taught and extremely talented. His love for painting and generosity in sharing what he knew with others made him well liked and very popular. His family has now established the annual "Robert Doyle Memorial Prize" (trophy and monetary prize) awarded to the best "Bush Painting" by an Art Society member.

Visitors are invited to join the Art Society. The Society is known for its friendly, cheerful atmosphere where everyone wants to learn more about art. The Art Society sees itself in the role of fostering the development of art, painting in various mediums such as oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastel, line and wash as well as drawing in pencil and charcoal. ## Monthly Members' Meetings

These are held on the 4th Thursday of the month, February to November, from 10am to around noon at The Uniting Church Hall, 204 The Entrance Rd, Long Jetty 2261.

After a short report from the President to update members on society activities there may be a guest speaker, a demonstration or a talk on some aspect of art. This is followed by morning tea.

From time to time, when advised accordingly, members are invited to bring one of their recent paintings for assessment and receive some useful hints from the Art Director or one of our experienced artists. This is done in an encouraging way which members find helpful and enjoyable.

Also at some meetings members are asked to bring along paintings on a chosen theme and a People's Choice selection is used to select two of the best paintings.

## The Academy

**Academy Sessions** for all mediums are held at the CWA Building, 1 Pacific Street, Long Jetty from 9am to 12 noon on Wednesdays. Members bring along their own materials and chosen work in any medium and can be guided by the "mentor-in-charge". Morning tea is provided.

Cost is \$10 per session.

## Art Exhibitions

Art exhibitions are promoted to the community and are restricted to the work of members only. Varying venues are utilised, as appropriate. All works are for sale with a commission payable to the Art Society.

## Workshops

From time to time these are arranged, with tuition by a professional artist/tutor. They are usually a full-day program with a lunch break (BYO). Bookings are essential and pre-payment is required. Non-members are welcome to attend.

## Fab Fakes Exhibition

This is a showcase of 'recreated artworks' (*copies*) of past famous artists, such as Monet, Renoir, Van Gogh, Turner, Streeton, McCubbin, Roberts and many others. Artists must comply with current copyright laws.
