CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All stall holders must have public liability insurance certificate attached to the application (TLAS Members are exempt).
2. Food stall holders are to attach a copy of their Food Approval or Permit (if selling food), and Food Safety Certificate.
3. Temporary for stall applications can be obtained at:

4. While utmost care will be exercised, neither Tuggerah Lakes Art Society Inc, nor its members will be responsible for insurance, loss, damage to any items.
5. Stall holders are required to supply their own equipment such as marquee/gazebo, sandbags, tables, and chairs.
6. Make sure all rubbish is removed from your site at the end of the day.
7. Entry fees are to be paid with the application form. No refund will be given due to cancellation of event caused by circumstances beyond the control of the committee. Nor will a refund be given for a stall holder cancellation.
8. Trading times are between 10am and 3pm. Markets are not to pack up before 3pm, unless approval has been given by a committee member.
9. No commission will be charged on sales.
